EMERGENCY LAWS (TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS)

Food (Labelling)

THE LABELLING OF FOOD (AMENDMENT No. 2) ORDER, 1947.
DATED SEPTEMBER 15, 1947.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulation 2 of the Defence (Sale of Food) Regulations, 1943(a), as having effect by virtue of the Emergency Laws (Transitional Provisions) Act, 1946(b), and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Labelling of Food Order, 1946, as amended(c), shall be further amended by adding to Article 5 thereof, which relates to special requirements where the presence of vitamins or minerals is claimed, the following paragraph:—

“(8) Nothing in this Article shall, in relation to butter, prohibit the giving of a label or the publishing of an advertisement which correctly and truthfully claims that the butter in respect of which the claim is made is a natural source of vitamin A, notwithstanding that the minimum quantity of vitamin A contained therein is not specified.”

2. This Order shall come into force on the first day of October, 1947, and may be cited as the Labelling of Food (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1947.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This amending Order permits a claim on a label and in an advertisement that butter is a natural source of vitamin A without requiring the quantity to be specified.
