## Labelling of Food Order, 1950

- 1. I am directed by the Minister of Food to send for the information of the Authority a copy of S.I. 1950 No. 1061 which amends and consolidates the Labelling of Food Order, S.R. & O. 1946, No. 2169 (as amended).
- 2. The principal amendments are covered by the explanatory note to the Order but the Minister desires me particularly to point out that under the new Order he no longer holds power to grant licences or authorisations. To the extent that the Minister has been satisfied that the need still remains for certain exemptions, hitherto dealt with by the licensing procedure, provision has been made in the order (see items (a) to (e) and (k) of the explanatory note). In all other cases licences will have expired automatically by the 1st November, 1950, when the new Order comes into force.
- 3. A copy of the Circular and a copy of the enclosure are being sent to the Medical Officer of Health and a spare copy is enclosed for the Sampling Officer. Further copies may be obtained from H.M. Stationery Office at the addresses shown below.
