EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)

Food (Goat Meat)

THE GOAT MEAT (MAXIMUM PRICES) ORDER, 1941.

DATED NOVEMBER 19, 1941.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as amended, and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:

1. In this Order:

"The Minister" means the Minister of Food.
"Goat Meat" means the flesh of goats or kids.

"Sale by wholesale" means any sale other than a sale

by retail.

"Sale by retail" means any sale other than to a person buying for the purpose of re-sale, and includes a sale to a person for the purposes of a catering business.

- 2. Except under the terms and conditions of a licence granted by the Minister, no person shall sell or offer or agree to sell or expose for sale, or buy or offer or agree to buy goat meat at a price exceeding the maximum price applicable in accordance with the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The maximum price applicable on a sale of goat meat by wholesale is fixed on the basis of delivery being given by the seller at the buyer's premises, and includes all costs and charges of and incidental to that delivery, and no additional charge shall be made by the seller in respect of delivery, or for packing or packages.
- 4.—(1) No person shall sell or offer or agree to sell or expose for sale goat meat,

(a) by wholesale, otherwise than in whole carcases or in

sides

- (b) by retail, of a description or cut other than a description or cut specified in the first column of Part II of the Schedule to this Order, and no goat meat of a description or cut so specified shall be sold or offered or exposed for sale by retail unless it has been cut in accordance with the practice ordinarily followed by retailers of such meat in the district in which the seller's premises are situated.
- (2) Where on a sale by retail the maximum price of any goat meat includes any fraction of a farthing, that fraction shall be regarded as a farthing.

(3) No charge additional to the maximum price shall be made

for mincing goat meat.

5. No person shall in connection with the sale or disposition or proposed sale or disposition of any goat meat enter or offer to enter into any fictitious or artificial transaction or make or demand an unreasonable charge.

- 6. Every person who sells goat meat by retail shall keep posted in his premises in a conspicuous position, so as to be clearly visible to all customers throughout the whole time during which goat meat is being offered for sale, a notice stating in plain words and figures the maximum retail prices of all such meat.
- 7. The provisions of this Order shall not apply to the sale by a caterer of any cooked goat meat as part of a meal.

8. Infringements of this Order are offences against the Defence

(General) Regulations, 1939.

9. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of November, 1941, and may be cited as the Goat Meat (Maximum Prices) Order, 1941.
