This report outlines the issues which the Very Elderly face and how the solution attempts to resolve the issue. The findings can be transferred to other website for application use.




Figure 1. Among all American adults, % who use social networking sites, by age Reference: PewResearchCenter, "Social Media Usage: 2005-2015," 2015.

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
