

# James and Elizabeth Knowlson Scholarship, Department of Film, Theatre and Television: MA Samuel Beckett: Archive, Text and Performance

## DEADLINE 22 April 2016

The Department of Film, Theatre and Television is pleased to announce the availability of a Scholarship kindly donated by Professor James and Elizabeth Knowlson, for its MA *Samuel Beckett: Archive, Text and Performance*, run jointly with the Department of English, for the academic year 2016/17. This scholarship includes fees and, depending on the level of fees, a stipend of up to £7000. The amount of the scholarship offered to the successful applicant/s will be communicated to them at the time the award is offered.

## Terms and Conditions

1. To be considered, applicants must have applied for or accepted an offer of a place on the MA in *Samuel Beckett: Archive, Text and Performance* in the Department of Film, Theatre and Television. Applications for admissions into the MA programme and applications for a scholarship can be made at the same time, but a final decision on the scholarship will not be made until a place has been offered in the programme. Do not apply for a scholarship unless you have already applied, or are simultaneously applying, for admission into the MA in *Samuel Beckett: Archive, Text and Performance*
2. Applicants must meet the School's entry requirements. Awards are intended to acknowledge and support students with a very strong academic record.
3. A maximum of one scholarship will be awarded per student.
4. An award will only apply for the coming academic year and cannot be deferred.
5. Successful candidates will be contacted on an individual basis via email. Please allow up to 4 weeks following the scholarship deadline for a decision.
6. The School reserves the right to offer no awards if there are no suitable applicants.
