

Guidance for International Offer Holders

If you are an international applicant who requires a student route visa to enter the UK for your teacher training, you will not be able to apply for an Enhanced DBS check until you have obtained your visa and arrived in the UK. We are required to see a document showing that you have leave to enter or remain in the UK before processing your DBS application. We will therefore not be able to carry out the DBS check until you have arrived at the University.

Once you have met all of the other conditions attached to your offer, including providing a [Letter of Good Conduct](#) from your home country, we will make your offer unconditional and issue your CAS number so that you can apply for your student route visa. Please note, we are unable to issue a CAS more than 6 months in advance of the start of the programme.

You will be permitted to provisionally enrol for the course, and we will carry out the DBS check when you have arrived in the UK and collected your Biometric Residence Permit.

Please contact us as soon as you arrive in the UK so that we can assist you with obtaining the DBS clearance.

Please be aware that in the event of the outcome of your DBS check revealing a conviction or caution which made you unsuitable to be admitted to teacher or early years training, you would be required to immediately withdraw from the programme.
