Work through some theory exercises (ABRSM, Trinity or Rock School to Grade 4/5 is sufficient) and make sure that you are comfortable reading different notations – staff and tab, including drums.

Create a free account with the cloud based Soundtrap (DAW) and Noteflight (Notation software) explore how they work. I am hoping to provide access to the education versions of these from September for use through the course.

Try composing a piece of film music to accompany a horror scene in a movie (GCSE no more than 2.5 minutes) and then create a song that you notate in Noteflight for vocals, keyboards, bass guitar and drum kit.
