To get support with	What you need to do...
Registering with the service	Please contact us prior to the start of term, and complete the required paperwork to register.
Applying for the Disabled Student Allowance	The DSA funding is available to eligible students with disabilities. Please apply online through the gov.uk website. https://www.gov.uk/disabled-students-allowances-dsas/overview
Accommodation	If you have any queries with regards to your accommodation, and adjustments please contact UPP and the Disability service, so that we can do our best to assist with this.
Induction support	Transitioning to university life can sometimes be a challenge. Please let us know in the summer of any support you think you may need to assist you with this.
Individual support or exam arrangements	Once your studies have commenced we would encourage you to speak to your disability adviser, or the disability office, to arrange an appointment to discuss support and adjustments we can provide you.
Health and Safety	Please inform us if you are aware that you need assistance to leave a building in the event of an emergency. We can make this plan with you.
