WITHDRAWALS AND SUSPENSIONS POLICY

The University' Rules and Regulations pages provides links to information regarding transferring, withdrawing or suspending from studies. The US Department of Education requires that a student's leave of absence, together with any additional leaves of absence, must not exceed a total of 180 days in any 12-month period. If a student is granted leave of absence by the University that does not meet this condition, and exceeds 180 days in any 12-month period, the University is required to report the student as withdrawn to the US Department of Education for Title IV purposes.
