The school journey checklist

If you have any questions or concerns, you can contact the government admission team, the school, or us (int.adv@reading.ac.uk). We cannot help you with filling in the application and cannot guarantee your child gets into specific schools, we can only advise you of the process.

- 1. Familiarise yourself with UK schooling system
- 2. Identify the schools near your UK home address
- 3. Visit schools to see which one you and your child prefer
- 4. Choose which school you would like your child to attend (always

choose more than one – you can list in your preference order, but there are no guarantees you will be given a place in your preferred choices)

- 5. Complete and send application
- 6. Wait for response
- 7. Once you have accepted the school, find out start date and school times (when school starts and finishes). If you are applying in the middle you will only have a limited time to accept and start in your school.
- 8. Make sure you find out all the important information about the school including drop off and collection times, school holidays and inset day dates.
- 9. Purchase school uniform (if the school requires your child to wear uniform). Most large supermarkets stock basic uniform supplies.
 - 10. Purchase school supplies for your child, if needed. Some schools may provide basic stationary but require children to provide other supplies. Check with your school.
