

Exam and assessment results for summer 2020 (for UG and PGT students)

Dear students,

We are writing to confirm that **all results will be published by the end of July** as follows:

w/c 20 July: Undergraduate finalists and postgraduate taught students

w/c 27 July: All undergraduate students (non-finalists and Foundation Year students)

We apologise that is later than our usual timeframes. Our top priority is the accuracy of your results and, as you can appreciate, we have had to amend our usual processes significantly given the ongoing impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. We understand how important it is for you to receive your results as quickly as possible and our dedicated teams are doing all they can to achieve this. We have provided further information and frequently asked questions below.

Where will I find my results?

We will send you an email when your results are available to view on your RISIS portal. For undergraduate finalists and taught postgraduate students, this will be during the week commencing Monday 20 July. For all other students, this will be during the week commencing Monday 27 July.

Before you receive your results, we will contact you with further information about how to interpret them, along with advice about the different options available to you if you feel your results do not reflect your academic ability.

What if I asked to defer but then chose to take my exam?

If you submitted a Circumstances Impact Process (CIP) request to defer but then subsequently chose to take your exams, your papers have been marked and will be included in your overall results calculation.

Can I request to retake exams or assessments if I feel the results do not reflect my ability?

Once you have received your results, you can request to retake assessments and/or exams, without penalties or capping of marks. Resits will be held in September.

You have five working days after receiving your results to make this request using the [Circumstances Impact Process](#). We strongly recommended that you seek advice from your School or department as soon as possible within these five working days to help you decide whether you should retake. Take the time to consider all your available options, with support from us, before making a decision. We will provide further information nearer the time, before you receive your results.

What if I need my results earlier (for example, for a postgraduate study or job application)?
