HERE TO HELP

Our Graduation Ambassadors (in red t-shirts) are here to welcome you to the celebrations and can help you find your way around campus.

FIRST AID

If you require emergency assistance at any time please alert a member of staff. Alternatively, there is a first aid point in room G07 in Building 33.

INFORMATION DESK AND TICKET DESK

Guests and graduands can find the information desk in the marquee on the lawn. Guest tickets can be collected from the ticket desk located next to the information desk.

SHUTTLE BUS

The free shuttle bus service running between our London Road and Whiteknights campus starts at 7.30am each day. The last bus leaves at 5.30pm. The drop off and pick up point is shown below.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Guests and blue badge holders who have reserved parking at our London Road campus can go directly to the White Gates carpark where our Security team will assist.



GUESTS | TIMETABLE FOR THE DAY

Welcome to Graduation Day!

We want you to enjoy your day celebrating the achievements of your Graduand so we have put together a suggested timetable for your day. This timetable below should act as a guide, however, tasks marked **red** are compulsory and time critical.

120 Minutes – 90 minutes prior to ceremony start time

Arrival: Once at Whiteknights Campus, you'll be shown where to park and directed to the free shuttle bus down to the London Road Campus. Our Graduation Ambassadors can assist you to the buses and the marquees on the lawns. This is your first chance to find the toilets, chat to the Alumni team, browse our retailers and have a cup of tea!

90 Minutes – 60 minutes prior to ceremony start time

Students collect their guest tickets and robes: Students need to collect their guest tickets from the ticket desk in the information and ticket collection marquee. While doing this they can ask about availability of extra tickets; any extra tickets are free of charge, with a maximum of two extra per student if available. Students should then collect their robe from Student Gown Collection in Building 22.

NB. This area in Building 22 is for Graduands only so you may want to wait in the marquees or on the lawns and have a designated meeting place.

60 Minutes – 45 minutes prior to ceremony start time

Relax! Now there is time for souvenir shopping, to purchase some refreshments or walk around the beautiful grounds and take pictures. You may decide that now is a good time to have the official Ede & Ravenscroft photo taken, however this can also be done after the ceremony. The studio photography area permits guests, so you can accompany your Graduand.

45 Minutes prior to ceremony start time

Student Processions: All Graduands must register in the student processions marquee 45 minutes before their ceremony starts. **The doors to the procession marquee will be closed 30 minutes before the ceremony and any graduands arriving late will not be able to take part in their ceremony.** You will see your Graduand after the hour long ceremony and it may be useful to decide on a meeting place afterwards.

If you have guest tickets, you can make your way towards the Great Hall. Anyone without tickets for the Great Hall can watch the ceremonies live in the Video Relay Rooms in Building 22.

After the ceremony

Celebrate your Graduate's success! The rest of the time is now yours! The only thing you need to do is to remind your Graduate to return their robes.

There may be the opportunity for graduates to celebrate with academic staff at a department reception, take more pictures, perhaps go to the marquee or The Dairy in Building 14 for some refreshments, or meet course mates. Don't forget to do the mortarboard toss!
