A 3 day program ensured the wc was out of action for the minimum time possible. Day 1: remove lights. Day 2: remove asbestos ceiling tiles and air test. Day 3: fit new false ceiling and lights.

Maintenance Services are now able to carry out drainage repairs.

Did you know?

This project came into being following drainage problems in the wc on the floor above . The drainage pipes run through the floor and into the ceiling void of the floor below.

Asbestos ceiling tiles are safe when left undisturbed. Removing the tiles to gain access to the ceiling void causes sufficient disturbance to warrant full and carefully controlled removal and disposal.
