The original office areas within the 2No rooms, were 5No small individual offices for post graduate students. The client required this space to be modified, to create an open plan office area and a 50 seat small lecture room for the sole use of the department for teaching purposes.

#### The Solution

The removal of all the individual offices, and the formation of an open plan office area, together with the formation of a 50 seat small lecture room, for the sole use by the department, together with a general upgrading of the ceiling finishes, decorations and floor coverings within the space and the enhancement of the lighting, electrical and data sockets provisions within the open plan area.

### The Benefits

The open plan office area provides better interaction between the post graduate students and a suitable teaching space has been created to teach 50 students within the department.
