

GUIDANCE FOR VISITORS

Welcome to Whiteknights

CAMPUS PRINCIPLES

In general, visitors are required to:

- · Act lawfully at all times;
- Adhere to the University's rules and regulations;
- Follow instructions given by the University Staff;
- Respect all members of the University's community;
- Not discriminate against or harass any member of the University's community or any other visitor to the Campus; and
- Not causing a nuisance (including excessive noise).

In addition, visitors must:

GENERAL

- · Keep to the paths;
- Keep all children accompanying them under close supervision at all times;
- Park only in designated areas where permitted to do so, and not on grass, under trees or on plantings;
- Not leave litter, light fires or use barbeques
- Keep away from buildings and research areas;

Not engage in fly tipping (including green waste);

WILDLIFE

- Not disturb wildlife, pick flowers or climb trees;
- Not remove timber or fire wood, plants, bulbs or plant material;
- Not undertake commercial fungi collection;
- For bio-security, when visiting the Campus grounds and wood ensure boots are clean and treated with suitable biocide if visitors have been walking on other sites;

RECREATION

- Not roller-skate, skate-board or kite-fly;
- · Not fly drones;
- Not use the lake for swimming, water sports and activities;
- Not use the Campus for shooting, archery, golf or other projectile sports;
- Not use the Campus for camping or rough sleeping;
- Not hold or attend unauthorised parties or gatherings;
- Not carry out metal detecting, bottle collecting or other activities that result in excavation:
- Fish only if given permission by the University to do so;

DOGS

- Keep dogs on leads and under control at all times;
- Keep dogs away from sports pitches;
- Take dog fouling away for disposal; and
- Not use the Campus for commercial dog walking
