EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)

Food (Bacon)

ORDER, DATED FEBRUARY 14, 1942, AMENDING THE BACON (ADDITION OF BORAX) ORDER, 1940.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as amended, and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Bacon (Addition of Borax) Order, 1940(a), as amended(b) (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order"), shall be further amended by substituting in Article 4A of the Principal Order for the words "the 14th February, 1942" the words "the 16th May, 1942."

2. Copies of the Principal Order hereafter to be printed under the authority of His Majesty's Stationery Office shall be printed in accordance with the amendment provided for by this Order and the Principal Order shall take effect as hereby amended.
