# EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)

Food (Saccharin)

GENERAL LICENCE, DATED MAY 28, 1943, UNDER THE SACCHARIN (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICES) ORDER, 1942.

- 1. Pursuant to Article 8 of the above Order(a), and notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3B thereof, the Minister of Food hereby authorises any person until the 24th day of July, 1943, to use in the manufacture or preparation of any "food" (within the meaning of the last mentioned Article) any stocks of saccharin solution, dulcin solution, saccharin in powder form, dulcin, soluble saccharin or sweetening powder of which he took delivery before the date of this licence.
  - 2. This licence shall come into force on the 30th day of May, 1943.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

General Licence under the Saccharin (Control and Maximum Prices) Order, 1942.

Article 3B of the Saccharin (Control and Maximum Prices) Order, 1942, as amended, provides that after the 29th day of May, 1943, no person shall by way of trade use any saccharin solution, dulcin solution, saccharin in powder form, dulcin, soluble saccharin or sweetening powder in the manufacture or preparation of any food or drink for human consumption (other than drugs) including any article which ordinarily enters into or is issued in the composition or preparation of human food and any flavouring matter or condiment. It is provided, however, that saccharin solution, saccharin in powder form and soluble saccharin may be used in the manufacture or preparation of any soft drink.
