- had Prudential AVCs which have now been transferred across to this section of the Scheme.

If you haven't already signed up for **the match**, simply make your election via [My USS](#) to benefit from additional contributions from your employer of 1% of your pensionable pay. If you haven't yet registered for My USS, you'll need your member number (available from the USS member service desk on 0333 300 1043).
