

Rotary Graduate Scholarship Programme

Through the generosity of Rotary District 1090, which represents the Rotary Clubs in the Thames Valley area, a scholarship of USD 30,000 has been offered each year to a University of Reading international master's student from a low or middle-income country. The Rotary Graduate Scholarship typically targets support at a specific subject area and this year the focus will be protecting the environment, with three master's programmes in our Department of Geography and Environmental Science and Graduate Institute of International Development, Agriculture and Economics eligible for the award. Scholarship candidates will be expected to demonstrate in their funding application how their master's studies will meet the requirements of this area of environmental focus. Scholarship applications should only be submitted after receiving an offer of admission from the University of Reading to one of the above full-time courses. Applications open on 1 January 2022 and close at 5pm (UK time) on 8 April 2022. Shortlisted applicants will be invited for interview by Skype in early May 2022.
