Key information about the Henley Business School Emerging Leaders Experience

1. Henley Business School Emerging Leaders Experience ("the Experience") is a non-assessed, non-qualification, non-credit-bearing personal development experience.
2. The Experience will be available to any student enrolled on a participating University of Reading postgraduate programme¹ commencing in the academic year 2020/21 – see full list of participating programmes on **page 3**.
3. The Experience will be offered at no additional cost to students enrolled on participating programmes as specified in point 2 above.
4. The Experience will be delivered entirely online and will not include contact time to enable flexibility of engagement for students.
5. Participation in the Experience is entirely voluntary.
6. Registration for the Experience will take place during the autumn term. Enrolled students on participating programmes (see point 2 above) will be contacted to inform them once registration is open².
7. The Experience will be delivered in three phases, commencing in January 2021. All content will remain available to participating students once launched.
 - a. Participating student engagement with all phases of the Experience will be monitored by Henley Business School.
 - b. In order to ensure that an individual student's participation in the Experience is included on their diploma supplement and for them to receive a certificate of attendance from Henley Business School, participating students must register and engage with all three phases of the Experience by October 2021³.
 - c. However, participating students will retain access to all materials included in the Experience until their point of graduation from their Master's degree programme⁴.
8. Participating students must ensure that they meet the requirements of their degree programme, which should be their priority. The Experience is supplemental to the degree programme and participation in it cannot be used as grounds for extenuation.
9. Participation in the Experience cannot be used as 'credit' towards a degree programme.

¹ Unfortunately we are unable to offer the Experience alongside all of our Master's programmes. This is mainly due to restrictions put in place by external accreditation bodies or workload capacity constraints.

² Students will be contacted using their University email address which will be allocated at the point of enrolment on their Master's degree programme.

³ Participating students will be informed of the exact date as soon as it is available.

⁴ For part-time students, access to the Experience will remain throughout the duration of their degree programme until the point of their graduation – they will be informed in due course of the date by which they will need to engage with each of the three phases of the Experience to ensure this is included on their diploma supplement.
